

RESIDENT SPOTLIGHT: IRENE KIRK

Irene was born Irene Conhan and both of her parents are of Irish descent. When her family emigrated from Ireland, they found employment in the anthracite coal mines of Pennsylvania. One of her uncles was Black Jack Kehoe. He belonged to a group called the "Molly McGuires." Discouraged by the shabby treatment at the hands of their employers, Uncle Jack and his cohorts founded the United Mine Workers (UMW), which went on to become a prominent labor union. A movie has been made about their exploits.

Favorite activities of Irene's youth include vocal music, Putt-Putt Golf and making friends. Irene attended high school in Atlanta GA. She and her friends often visited the nearby campus of Georgia Institute of Technology... The Ramblin' Wreck of Georgia Tech.

At age 18, Irene married a Colombian student who had just been offered a position with Allis Chalmers, an international corporation, at their Colombian location in Cohentos Del Vale.

Irene didn't know Spanish when she arrived in Colombia, a country where English was not even a second language. She jokingly said that "I did not want anyone talking about me" so she went around with a pocket Spanish-English dictionary to get some idea on what was being said. When shopping, she would point to the products and, with the seller's help, locate the name of the product in the dictionary. Fortunately, Irene is gifted with an excellent memory, so it wasn't long before she became fluent in Spanish.

She lived in Colombia for three years before returning to the USA... this time to Wisconsin. She lived there for one year and during that time her daughter Mercedes was born.



Then she moved to the land she had grown to love... back to Columbia again and her son Guillermo was born there.

A dominant feature of Colombia is that the Roman Catholic Church is part of the government. This, of course, is quite unlike the USA.

After this second Colombian stint, Irene moved back to Ohio and eventually to Westerly Apartments. She obtained her Registered Nurse Certification at Cuyahoga Community College and worked as a nurse for fifty years!

At the Westerly, Irene continues those favorite activities of her youth: singing at Ron and Lilly's Karaoke, teaching Spanish in the Westerly Community Room on Tuesdays and continuing to make many friends. She has also added gardening to her list of activities and has tilled a garden plot here for 10 years! This year she shared a garden spot with Esteban.

Irene is an active member of the Lakewood Baptist Church which has a large contingent of Swahili speaking Africans and another contingent from Korea. This fits right in with Irene's international flair. She looks forward to the next step that Lakewood Baptist is taking... holding joint activities with Lakewood United Methodist Church. She believes this will vitalize both communities!

I have found Irene to be a very vibrant Senior Citizen!
